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Though fired to 1080°C to make them as frost resistant as possible, we would always recommend the following to prevent waterlooging and avoid any risk of flaking/crumbling:

- Use pot feet to elevate pots off the ground. This will prevent the base from soaking up water and freezing. It will also allow proper drainage
- Move pots (both empty and full) to a sheltered spot in the colder months. Empty pots can be stored upside down and slightly elevated to limit contact with the ground.
- If it is not possible to move pots to a sheltered spot, they should be wrapped in a double layer of hessian or an old towel to protect them from freezing.
- Never leave pots sitting in a tray of water over winter. Remove the tray and either leave it out as a bird bath or store it somewhere sheltered.
